The Anterior Periodontal Implant Controversy from My 30+ Years Experience

The decision to save or replace teeth in the anterior dentition places tremendous pressure on the periodontist and the restorative dentist to design a smile line that restores the patient's self-confidence and satisfaction. Many times, we are faced with traumatic or infectious conditions affecting the Esthetic Zone that challenge our ability to achieve the desired esthetic result. We will be identifying the benefits and potential short- and long-term risks involved in saving teeth or replacing them with implants in the anterior dentition. While minimally invasive surgery is often sufficient to preserve anterior esthetics, technological advances in soft and hard tissue reconstruction, may sometimes be required to achieve our patient's demands for the Esthetic Zone.
